Warrington Rowing Club Competitor Parking - Guidance & Map

All please bring wellies – the track down to and areas around the club are muddy due to building work.

Do not park cars on Kingsway Bridge. This will affect the traffic on this main road and is unsafe. Parking restrictions may well be in place.

The track section of Howley lane down to the club is badly pot holed and house building activity has narrowed this route. Only trailers with towing vehicles, race officials / helpers cars should proceed down the track to club at low speed and with caution. Any parking must provide sufficient width for emergency services to access the club and landing stage at all times. Please do not park vehicles in front of the new houses on Howley Lane.

Competitors are requested to park cars at the top tarmacked sections of Howley Lane, Holmesfield Road and Farrell Street. Permission has also been granted by several businesses at the top of Howley Lane to use their car parks. Faircloughs Ltd is one of these businesses. Club helpers will provide guidance on the day. If parking on Farrell Street, it is possible to short cut on foot through the housing estate to Howley Lane. Other parking options include using Victoria Park and walking around the playing fields to Kingsway Bridge. Pedestrian tunnels under the bridge, and side paths up to road on west side of bridge give access to club without having to cross the busy main road.
