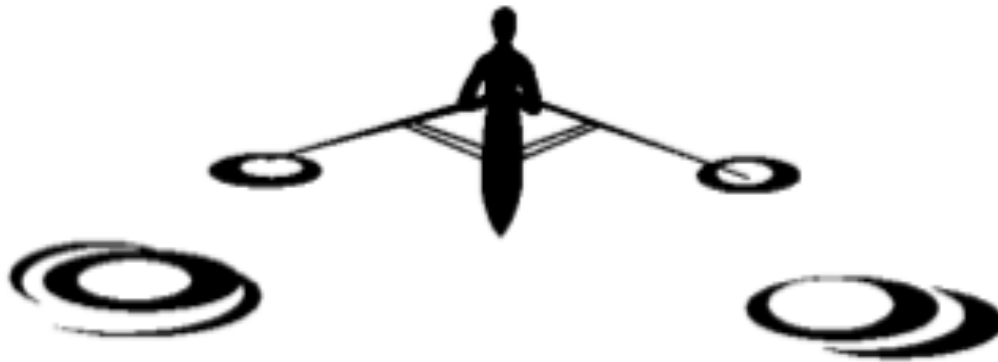


# Warrington Regatta

## Conditions of Entry

1. The regatta is open to all Club and Composite crews and is held under British Rowing Rules of Racing.
2. Entry fees are not refundable once the draw is published. In event of the regatta being cancelled by the Regatta Race Committee, in whole or in part, the Entries Committee reserves the right to refund any entry fees to crews in events not raced.
3. Events and entry fees are as listed and are available on BROE.
4. Clubs are reminded it is their responsibility to insure their equipment and to ensure that those they are entering are prepared and competent to race.
5. Competitors must provide their own boats and blades.
6. **All doubling up (competitors and equipment) to be notified to the regatta secretary at the time of entry.**
7. The entries committee reserve the right to alter the list of entries to correct a mistake of the regatta.
8. Minimum of 3 entries from two different clubs are required for an event to be held. If insufficient entries are received, the entries will be placed in the next age group or status group for the class of boat unless an alternative is stated.
9. All competitors must provide a valid British Rowing registration card, which will be retained until each competitor has completed racing, prior to collecting their race number.

## Prizes

1. Winners of Seniors events will receive Warrington Regatta Tankards.
2. Winners of Junior events will receive Warrington regatta Medals.
